

HERE IS YOUR PACKING CHECKLIST

When packing for a safari, it is best to pack comfortable clothes and not too many! Here is a few tips to consider when packing:

1. Try bring as little as possible, in a medium size duffel bag. Try avoiding using hard case luggage.
2. Avoid bright clothing and try stick to neutral coloured clothing
3. For the ladies, sports bras are recommended for bumpy 4x4 trails
4. Avoid high heels and skirts (this can make getting on and off Safari vehicles awkward!)
5. Avoid camoflauge or military clothing
6. Early morning game drives can get cold - bring warm clothes!
