When packing for a safari, it is best to pack comfortable clothes and not too many! Here is a few tips to consider when packing:

- 1. Try bring as little as possible, in a medium size duffel bag. Try avoiding using hard case luggage.
- 2. Avoid bright clothing and try stick to neutral coloured clothing
- 3. For the ladies, sports bras are recommended for bumpy 4x4 trails
- 4. Avoid high heels and skirts (this can make getting on and off Safari vehicles awkward!)
- 5. Avoid camoflauge or military clothing
- 6. Early morning game drives can get cold bring warm clothes!
